The Syracuse Metropolitan Transportation Council (SMTC) is currently conducting the Route 5 Transportation and Land Use Analysis on behalf of the Village of Fayetteville. SMTC staff have examined traffic flow patterns, historical trends, current and past planning efforts, future development potential in the village, and anticipated future impacts to the transportation system. We will review this information at the meeting on Wednesday, February 28, 2018, and seek your input on appropriate roadway enhancements to help achieve the community's vision for the future.
