



NOTICE OF PUBLIC REVIEW PERIOD FOR THE 2018-2019 UNIFIED PLANNING WORK PROGRAM (UPWP) DRAFT DOCUMENT

The Syracuse Metropolitan Transportation Council (SMTC) has begun the official public comment period on the draft 2018-2019 Unified Planning Work Program (UPWP) document. The SMTC is the designated Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) for all of Onondaga County and a small portion of Oswego and Madison Counties. The UPWP is the required document that details the planning activities and funding that will be undertaken by the MPO and its member agencies each year.

The final, approved document is not yet available; however, draft document is available for review. The public review/comment period commenced on January 14, 2018. Comments received on or before February 13, 2018 will be considered for the final 2018-2019 UPWP, to be presented to the SMTC Policy Committee for official adoption in February 2018.
