

# EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

## Connections to Township 5: Bicycle & Pedestrian Assessment— Draft Final Report

**Objective:** To have the Policy Committee acknowledge the completion of the Connections to Township 5: Bicycle & Pedestrian Assessment report.

**Considerations:** The Town of Camillus requested that the SMTC assess the existing transportation system, identify bicycle and pedestrian access issues, and identify potential bicycle and pedestrian improvements along various corridors leading to the Township 5 development in the Town. These corridors include Knowell Road, Township 5 Boulevard, Milton Avenue, Hinsdale Avenue, and Warners Road.

The Connections to Township 5: Bicycle and Pedestrian Assessment includes recommendations for improved shoulders, sidewalks, sharrows, shared use paths, and railroad crossings. Access in and around the Township 5 development was a focal point of this study.
