WHEREAS, This project is sponsored by the City of Syracuse (City); and

WHEREAS, PIN 375649 is not currently listed in the 2017-2021 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP); and

WHEREAS, The City of Syracuse is identified in the New York State Pedestrian Safety Action Plan (PSAP) as a focus community, and as such, federal highway safety improvement funds were made available via a statewide PSAP funding solicitation; and

WHEREAS, The City of Syracuse will utilize the federal safety funding noted in the table below to address pedestrian safety concerns at numerous uncontrolled crosswalks and signalized intersections around the City; and
