The Syracuse Metropolitan Transportation Council (SMTC) is currently conducting the **Erie Boulevard East Pedestrian Study** on behalf of the New York State Department of Transportation (NYSDOT), the City of Syracuse, and the Town of Dewitt. The study is focused on **improving the pedestrian experience in the near term** along Erie Boulevard East between Beech Street and East Genesee Street, without significantly reconstructing the corridor. We have documented many existing conditions in the corridor, such as pedestrian facilities, bus stop locations, accident data and surrounding land uses. We are looking for input from the public on how the corridor is currently used and on existing transportation issues in the corridor, especially those that relate to walking and bicycling.
