



## **Internship Opportunity for Summer 2024**

The Syracuse Metropolitan Transportation Council is looking for interested applicants for a paid summer internship opportunity.

The internship is related to transportation planning and Geographic Information Systems (GIS) data collection.

This position will primarily inventory sidewalks and related infrastructure in support of the City of Syracuse's Municipal Sidewalk Program (MSP). This inventory is completed by traversing the city on foot and collecting the appropriate information on a tablet. The internship includes substantial training to identify different sidewalk elements in the field and how to properly record them.

Additional data collection tasks may include vehicular and pedestrian traffic counts. Training will be provided for these activities.

Qualifications include responsible, attentive, strong interpersonal, communication and organizational skills, and the ability to work as part of a team. Early morning availability for sidewalk data collection is preferred. Working knowledge of Microsoft Office and Apple iPads desired. Access to personal transportation is a plus.

This internship pays approximately \$19/hour (DOQ) for a maximum of 40 hours a week. Opportunities to complete the required work within a "compressed" work week (i.e. 4 days per week) exist.

The SMTC is flexible in terms of start and end date of the internship depending on the chosen candidate's needs.
