- WHEREAS,** This project is sponsored by the City of Syracuse (City); and
- WHEREAS,** PIN 375624 is currently listed in the 2023-2027 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) with a federal fund amount of \$2,690,000; and
- WHEREAS,** The City is proposing to add funds to the Construction phase, post obligation, in Federal Fiscal Year (FFY) 23/24 in the amount of \$380,000 NHPP federal funds, as reflected in the table on the following page; and
- WHEREAS,** The compensating offset is being provided by available planning target funds; and
- WHEREAS,** This reflects a cumulative cost of a phase increase (less than an increase of \$500,000) and is being brought to the Executive Committee for review and approval; and
- WHEREAS,** The SMTC 2023-2027 TIP and the NYSDOT STIP would remain fiscally constrained with the approval of this change.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the SMTC Executive Committee endorses the above action and modification of the 2023-2027 TIP and NYSDOT STIP.

Announcement of public comment period Amendment to 2023-2027 Transportation Improvement Program

The Syracuse Metropolitan Transportation Council (SMTC) is seeking public comment on the proposed amendment relative to the 2023-2027 Transportation Improvement Program. This action includes the following:

Change in cost

- PIN 375624 (WEST GENESEE ST RD IMPROVEMENT PROJECT, CITY LINE TO S SALINA ST, SYRACUSE, ONONDAGA CO).
 - Sponsor City of Syracuse (City). Per the latest engineer's estimate, the City is proposing to increase the Construction phase in Federal Fiscal Year (FFY) 23/24 by \$380,000 NHPP federal funds to complete additional sidewalk work and other miscellaneous improvements. Compensating offset provided by available NHPP planning target.
