Announcement of public comment period Amendment to 2023-2027 Transportation Improvement Program

The Syracuse Metropolitan Transportation Council (SMTC) is seeking public comment on the proposed amendments relative to the 2023-2027 Transportation Improvement Program. The action includes the following:

Addition or deletion of project

- Following the latest TAP-CMAQ solicitation administered by the New York State Department of Transportation (NYSDOT), four projects in the SMTC area were identified by Governor Hochul for funding award in June 2024. Projects are listed below, including their total cost to be programmed on the TIP and Statewide TIP and when the Construction phase is anticipated.
 Preliminary Engineering phases are not listed but are a component of the Total cost.
