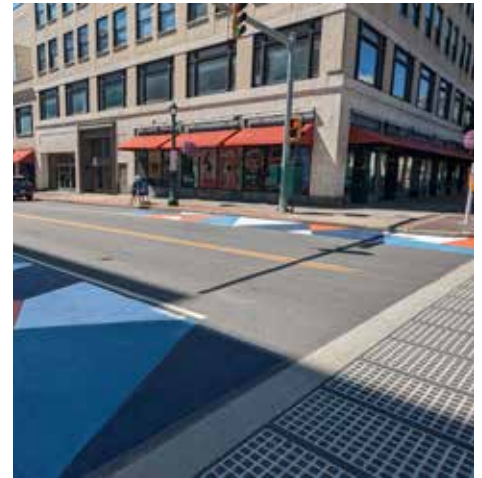




2025 Community Streets: Syracuse Urbanism Collective

The Syracuse Urbanism Collective aims to improve pedestrian safety and accessibility through the use of painted curb extensions at the S Salina St / Jefferson St intersection in Downtown Syracuse. The colors were selected to mimic the newly adopted Syracuse flag as an additional way to bring civic pride to the central business district while visually narrowing the roadway and reinforcing existing parking regulations. Additionally, a temporary bike corral will provide convenient bike parking near one of the major bike routes through the City of Syracuse.
