

Geddes Street Issues + Opportunities  
Geddes/Fayette Complete Streets Review

**Issues**

- 1 No connection to existing bike lanes
- 2 -Some queuing at peak times  
-Narrow sidewalk under bridge
- 3 Signs prohibit ped crossing. Lacks direct access to school
- 4 Wide driveways without sidewalk
- 5 High volumes to/from Grand Ave create operational challenges
- 6 Parent drop-off/pick-up impacts traffic flow and presents safety concerns
- 7 Ped generators on both sides of Geddes, but no crosswalks south of Delaware

**Opportunities**

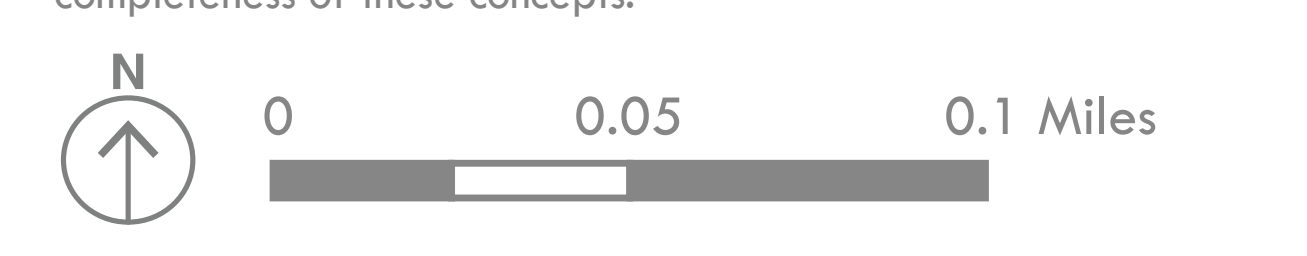
- Reconfigure northbound approach, OR  
-Add sidepath to west side between Erie Blvd and Fayette St.
- Remove signal at Otisco St and add pedestrian activated crossing at W Marcellus St; add walkway along W Marcellus St, OR  
-Keep signal at Otisco St and open fence along school property; add pathway to school
- Add appropriate sidewalk
- Consider a roundabout (requires additional analysis)
- Work with SCSD to improve arrival/dismissal. Investigate options for designated parent vehicle "standing"
- Add crosswalk with flashers
- Add crosswalks at Rowland St, OR  
-Consider a roundabout (requires additional analysis)
